**REGULATION TITLE AND NUMBER:** Educational Research Center for Child Development (4.011).

**SUMMARY:** The Division of Student Affairs is requesting approval for clarifying revisions of FAU Regulation 4.011, Educational Research Center for Child Development, consistent with Board of Governors Regulation 10.004 and Florida Statutes, Section 1011.48. The regulation was last updated in 1987. This regulation amendment shall be effective August 6, 2012.

## Regulation 4.011 Educational Research Center for Child Development.

- (1) The Educational Research Center for Child Development (the "Center") at Florida Atlantic University shall be an early childhood center—is established to provide educational opportunities and practical experience to Florida Atlantic Students interested schools or departments of FAU through internships, supervised teaching and educational research experiences; and to provide <u>care and</u> a high-quality educational environment/experience for the children of FAU students, staff and faculty both graduate and undergraduate, faculty, and other staff and employees of the University. The Center shall give highest priority to serving the children of students, followed by the children of staff and faculty. The Center's admission process shall be inclusive of race, ethnicity, socio-economic status, gender, as well as mental and physical ability.
- (2) There shall be a Director for the Center, selected by the <u>Dean of the College of Education and approved by the Advisory Board of Directors (the "Board")</u> of the Center. The Board <u>of Directors</u> shall consist of the President of the University or his/her designee, the Student Government <u>Association</u> President or his/her designee, the Chairperson of each department participating in the Center or his/her designee, and one parent for each 50 children enrolled in the Center, elected by the parents of children enrolled in the <u>center.Center.</u> The Director of the Center shall be an ex officio, nonvoting member of the Board. The Board shall establish local policies and perform local oversight and operational guidance for the Center, and <u>iensure</u> that the <u>ERCCD Center</u> is operated in accordance with the laws of Florida and <u>the rules</u>, regulations, <u>and policies</u> of Florida Atlantic University and the Board of <u>Regents.Governors</u>.
- (3) The Center is funded throughby a portion of the Capital Improvement Trust Fund FeesFee and user's other established fees- for childcare and services provided by the Center. Operations may also be financed by Student Activity and Service Fee allocations, grants, and donations, in accordance with the applicable law and the rules, regulations, and policies of Florida Atlantic University and the Board of Governors. The Center shall receive and monitor funds in accordance with the laws of Florida and the rules—and—a regulations, and policies—of Florida Atlantic University and the Board of Regents-Governors.
